### SYNOPSIS



Set in steaming sultry New Orleans, I'M YOUR MAN is an offbeat romantic comedy based on the French novel, "La Belle Image" by Marcel Aymé.

Ralph Clay – salesman, husband and father of two – is expecting to go through the motions of yet another day in his fairly monotonous life when a visit to the Department of Motor Vehicles radically alters his existence. Waiting for his turn in the never ending queue, Ralph dozes off and dreams he is in a funeral parade only to discover he is the one in the casket hoisted by the mourners. As Ralph cries out in anguish, "I am not ready to be dead", he wakes up to a miracle he doesn't even know has taken place.

"I'm sorry sir, these are not your photos" – this statement made by a DMV employee sets the stage for Ralph's subsequent realization: his face has miraculously changed! Gone are the bulldog features and baldness, replaced by youthful good looks. His voice and inner self are the same, but he has completely transformed on the outside.

Enter Roland Collins, Ralph's self-designated alter-ego, who will execute a series of ploys and deceptions in trying to maintain his "old life", while exploiting the fortunes of his new, and improved face. Roland rents the guest house across the way from where the Clays live and plans to seduce his wife Renee, aided by Renee's child-like Uncle Tony, the only one who knows Roland's real identity.

As illicit lovers, Roland and Renee are liberated from the preconceived notions and tedium that have maligned their marriage. Roland begins to see Renee in a new light, suddenly privy to her "hidden" selves. Renee, for the first time in her life, is awake with passion. Is Roland the lover her heart's been waiting for or merely a time-sensitive fling? When and if Ralph returns, what will his place be with the woman he thought he knew so well?

A provocative romantic comedy, I'M YOUR MAN reveals the many faces and layers that keep us apart and bring us together.


#### Jean-Louis Rodrigue, Producer

An internationally renowned acting coach, movement director and professor, Jean-Louis Rodrigue has worked on many Academy Award-winning films, plays, television, opera and music events. Most recently, he coached Christian Bale in the feature VICE, Rachel McAdams in DISOBEDIENCE and Margot Robbie on her Oscar-nominated role in I, TONYA, MARY, QUEEN OF SCOTS, and BIRDS OF PREY as well as Leonardo Di Caprio's riveting physical portrayal of Hoover in J EDGAR, Paul Dano in LOVE and MERCY and Matt Bomer in NOR-MAL HEART to name a few. He has worked with Berlinale Talents since 2009, developing the acting program and mentoring its participants. He is a professor at the UCLA School of Theatre, Film and Television and at the UCLA Herb Alpert School of Music.

#### Jo Edna Boldin, Casting Director, Producer

John C. Richards, Co-writer

John won the Best Screenplay award at the Cannes Film Festival for NURSE BETTY, which was based on his short story. The only American film to win an award that year, NURSE BETTY was also nominated for an Edgar. Richards wrote the voice-over narration (uncredited) in AMERICAN HISTORY X, and the screenplay adaptation of Clive Cussler's novel, SAHARA which starred Matthew McConaughey and Penelope Cruz. In 2017 he wrote PATERNO for HBO, the story of the fall of Penn State coaching legend Joe Paterno, which aired in April 2018, with Al Pacino in the lead role. Richards was nominated for a WGA Award for best long-form screenplay.
